



Eng. Rohan Fernando joined the NWS&DB as a Civil Engineer (Gr. IV) in October, 1994. Prior to joining the NWSDB he served in the NBRO and CECB altogether for 4 years. At CECB, he served in the Samanalaweva Dam Site and Power Station and obtained design and heavy construction experience to become a Chartered Engineer in 1994.

In the NWS&DB, he was first attached to the ADB funded Second Water & Sanitation project (ADB 1B) in the Southern Province. Thereafter in 1996 he was posted to the ADB 1C project implemented in the Central & UVA Provinces. In both

projects, he served as an Assistant Resident Engineer.

After completion of ADB 1C project, Eng. Rohan was transferred to the Head Office in 1999. There was a need to establish a technical unit under the line Ministry and he was seconded to the Ministry of Urban Development & Water Supply. He was designated as a Deputy Director in par with his Chief Engineer position in 2000. When the Tsunami Waves hit the coastal areas, Eng. Rohan was assigned the task of acting as a 'focal point' under the Ministry to pursue Donor Assistance from the Western World for Restoration Activities. He approached the European and US -Multi Donors to assist in the immediate relief activities under "Water & Sanitation".

With his innovative approach, he collaborated with Water Health International, USA to import 15 Package Water Treatment Plants and to install in the Tsunami Restoration Housing Sites. He was instrumental in the design and fabrication of the first mobile Water Testing Laboratory with Italian Grants, which was used for On-site Testing & Reporting in the Tsunami areas and later in the Manik Farm, Refugee Camp in the North.

His prime skill was in Contract Law and while he was serving as a Chief Engineer in the P&D Section, he exploited the provisions of NWSDB ACT and supported the NWSDB to get exempted from a massive rental for pipeline occupation on the RDA and Provincial Roads, which saved many Rs. Millions every year.

In the Arbitration conducted in the Greater Colombo Wastewater Management Project, he took the entire workload as the Project Director when the Senior Counsel withdrew from appearing, but endured a full-blown Arbitration and finally clinched the benefits for the NWSDB, which never seemed possible at the outset. His representations at the Arbitration were well appreciated by many Senior Counsels, which paved him the way to be enlisted in the IESL Directory of Adjudicators/ Arbitrators.

Eng. Rohan took over the Presidency of the Engineers Union at a very controversial time when many Seniors were reluctant to accept that role. Being only a Chief Engineer at that time, he encountered many challenges. He was very vise and prompt in intervening into a Court Case filed by other two Unions representing the technological stream against the Board to implement an exclusively-maneuvered promotional path that adversely affected the Engineers, which the Court finally decided in favor of Engineers Union's stance, recently in 2023 after a long hearing.

He very strategically challenged an attempt to amalgamate the Finance and Commercial Sections in the Board that might have camouflaged the "checks and balances" in the system, by filing action in the Courts on a technical point, which eventually gave a historical victory for the Engineers Union.

Eng. Rohan held the Presidency of the Engineers Union for 31/2 years, which may be the longest so far. He has obtained post graduate qualifications in construction management and International Relations and Masters in Business Management and International Business Law. In the IESL, he is a Fellow member and an Executive Council Member as well.

### 01. BASIS OF PREPARATION AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### 01.1 Basis of Preparation

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Sri Lankan Financial Reporting Standard for Small and Medium-sized Entities issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka. These financial statements are the separate financial statements of the Engineers' Union - National Water Supply & Drainage Board.

The functional currency of the organization is Sri Lankan Rupees. The financial statements of the entity are presented in Sri Lankan Rupees.

#### 01.2 Authorization For Issue

The financial statements of The Engineers' Union - National Water Supply & Drainage Board, for the year ended March 31, 2023, covering the period April 01, 2022 to March 31, 2023, were authorized for issue by the office bearers on August 28, 2023.

### 01.3 Going Concern

The office bearers are satisfied that The Engineers' Union - National Water Supply & Drainage Board has adequate resources to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future and continue to adopt the going concern basis in preparing and presenting these financial statements.

#### 01.4 Use of Estimates and Judgements

The preparation of the financial statements of the organization in conformity with the Sri Lanka Accounting Standards (SLFRS for SMEs) requires the management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of policies and reported amount of assets and liabilities, income and expenses.

#### 01.5 Cash & Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents are defined as cash in hand, demand deposits and short-term highly liquid investments, readily convertible to known amounts of cash and subject to insignificant risks of changes in value.

#### 01.6 Liabilities and Provisions

Liabilities are recognized in the balance sheet when there is a present obligation arising from a past event, the settlement of which is expected to result in an outflow of resources embodying economic benefits. Obligations payable at the demand of the suppliers or within one year of the balance sheet date are treated as current liabilities in the balance sheet. Liabilities payable after one year from the balance sheet date are treated as non-current liabilities in the balance sheet.

A provision is recognized in the balance sheet when the organization has a legal or constructive obligation as a result of a past event and it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits for which a reliable estimate could be made is required to settle the obligation.
